Skating - Matched the pace of the pack and positioned self to best assist infield referees; maintained proper positioning based upon skating system used.						
Rules Knowledge/Understanding - Demonstrated thorough knowledge of the rules set, including clarifications issued by the WFTDA Rules Committee.						
Ref-Skater Communication - Loudly, clearly, and through hand signals, indicated penalties, pack status, and jam removal cause to the skaters.						
Ref-to-Ref Communication - Primarily assisted infield referees, effective and accurate communication with outside NSOs/whiteboard operators.						
Overall - Accurately, consistently, and fairly monitored and communicated all penalties; accurately skated position designated by the Head Ref or venue
